All in favor, no one opposed.

APRIL 17, 1991


The B.W.G.A. Executive Committee met on April 17, 1991, at the home of President Geri Halkett, with Geri, Velma Stewart, Sharon Dauphinee, Dot Serota and Pat Sumner in attendance. Topics discussed were as follows:

1. Scrapbook - Since the club is in agreement that some of the pictures in the book should be removed, and Brenda Davis, as custodian of the book, would rather not do this on her own, Poppy Davis will be responsible for removing said pictures. If any member does not wish to have a picture of herself displayed in the book, Poppy and that member will remove it together.
2. Members are reminded that the July and August meetings will be held at the clubhouse at 7:30 AM.
3. The secretary will post the minutes of each meeting on the bulletin board in the Ladies' Lounge.
4. This year's invitational will be held on Thursday, July 11. The greens fee will be \$14.00. The luncheon will be held at The Greenhouse. We will have a chicken salad plate at a cost of \$6.00. The secretary will send a card to each course to be invited, informing them of the date. A letter with details will follow later. Austin has donated a stadium blanket to be used as a prize. He will also donate a major item for a raffle, the proceeds of which will go to the Ladies' Association. Each member should provide 4 prizes of a \$3 to \$5 value, related to golf. 6. Sharon will contact Wayne Huff about doing our handicaps.

7. Jan Annis has given the City Council a list of suggestions from members concerning the golf course. She attended a City Council meeting at which it was decided to appropriate \$15,000 to do a market survey on the course to see how it is doing and what should be done to fix it. We will hear more about this at a later date.

The luncheon will be held at The Greenhouse and will consist of a chicken salad platter costing \$6.00. The secretary has written to invited clubs informing them of the date. The limit will be 128, accepted on a first come, first served basis. Each member should provide 4 gifts of a \$3-5 value, related to golf. Four sets of head covers are needed for major gifts. Anne Winchester offered to knit one set. Brenda Davis has a pattern. Paul has donated a lesson to be raffled off locally. Austin has donated a stadium blanket for a prize.
