August 23rd BWGC meeting

Minutes read and accepted for July 19th meeting.

Treasurer's report...\$1987.36

First order of business was approval of October 1 as date of final banquet to be held at Captain Nick's.

It was announced that Gloria Attenweiler won President's Cup and Darlene Henderson was runner-up.

Mary Crawford reported that the Pairs League on Sunday afternoons is going very well. The average turn-out is 8 pairs and the next scheduled game will be one week after Labor Day.

Starting September 6th, Thursday tournaments will begin at 8:30 a.m.--shotgun start

The Rally for the Cure tournament was very successful as a check for \$600.00 was sent to the Susan Komen Foundation. Sandi Bourgoin won closest to the pin; she walked away with a new putter that has taken off at least 5 strokes from her game. (I'm taking some poetic license here).

A vote was taken and overwhelmingly passed that BWGC run another Rally for the Cure in 2008. There was discussion about bringing guests to this tournament and it was suggested that guest must not be a beginner golfer and that BWGC member (if bringing a guest) must make-up her own foursome. Also, a guest is not allowed to bring another guest...

Sandy Meehan suggested that next year the Men's group at Bangor Muni also run a Rally for the Cure Tournament as they seem to be interested.

The group was reminded that the State MWSGA will be held at the MUNI in 2008 and work on obtaining hotel rooms was under way. Also, volunteers will be called upon to help in this enormous, but very rewarding undertaking (more poetic license here).

Marilyn recapped the highs and lows of the Tee Cup; she stated that she and Sherrie Thomas will be reviewing and re-evaluating the format, which they both decided would be done at the end of the second year of the tournament. Possible changes may be made in the way pairings are done and in the format itself. Stay tuned...

For next year, President's Cup will require a sign-up format; any member interested in competing will have to sign-up ahead of time. The first round will be played on a Thursday; after that, members must arrange their own times to play.

Also, next year, Club Championship will be flighted so members will know beforehand what category they are in (Flight A,B,C). Unfortunately, this year was a bit of a mess as members were unaware of their flights and there was great confusion, primarily because they had a "nincompoop" running the tournament. Other changes discussed included setting specific dates for playing, taking average scores for the 4 best rounds and then determining flights based on these scores. More thought about this tournament is needed...

The last bit of business was a reminder that the Ringer Tournament is based on Net scores only...
