- Secretary's Report: Robin Ashe/Minutes taken by Jean Bridges in the absence of Robin.
  - Review of meeting minutes
     No discussion regarding the minutes of May 6, 2024.
- Treasurer's Report: Sandy Salsbury
  - Status of the treasury Sandy distributed the 2024 BWGC Projected Budget for 2024 and reviewed the budget projections and the overall setup of the spreadsheet. As of May 30, 2024 we have a current balance of \$4,134.07 which includes the dedicated YTD donations for Brenda Crosby which is \$1,620. Operating funds exclusive of that dedicated fund is \$2,514.07.
  - Membership numbers to date
     Sandy distributed copies of our most current Membership List. We currently have a total of 41 paid members (37/active GHIN and 4 NON/GHIN members)

- Handicap Chair Sue Coffin
  - Updates Mobile Scoring 1st trial –
     Our first trial use of the mobile app for our tournament last week was positive
  - Clarification on a few holes #2, #4, #7 and #15
     Sue reviewed the challenges that can arise in particular for holes #4 (the ditch) and #15 (the old pond area).
    - #4 a free lift when the ground is unmowed and standing water conditions
    - #15 last year the "old pond area" was considered ground under repair.
       This year is now "play it as it lies".
    - Correction regarding the "How to Score Sheet" that was passed out:
       Club Championship should not be included in the picking up and maxing out. The hole has to be played until the ball is in the cup.
